IQAC Report on Analysis Feedback of Stakeholders: 2021-22

A structured feedback system i.e., an online mechanism availing Google Forms was used to get the views and opinions of the students, alumni, and teaching fraternity on the prescribed curriculum. The questionnaire in this regard was prepared using different parameters: the difficulty level, relevance, practical application, and employability skills implanted in the current curriculum. The students, alumni, and teaching fraternity responded to the questionnaire and recorded their views, opinions, and observations through Google Forms. All the stakeholders, teaching faculties, and Heads of various departments were informed through social media platforms and notices about the schedules: and the opening and closing dates to record their feedback. The feedback was collected and further analyzed meticulously. The suggestions and observations received on feedback from the students were put forth in a discussion in the IQAC meeting and the same were later shared with the teaching faculties. The Principal and the IQAC Coordinator Dr. Manjusha Kulkarni took necessary measures after analyzing the data received. The feedback mechanism offered a comprehensive picture of the present Curriculum and the Teaching Learning and Evaluation Process and the need to adopt the changes in teaching learning methodology using ICT-enabled teaching to disseminate different concepts well and also to cater to the needs of all the stakeholders in the changing global scenario. The feedback mechanism is a guiding principle in understanding the students' opinions about the college environment and at the same, their expectations from the institute in the holistic journey of the institute towards its steady growth and development and also its concern for the students and their development through various programmes for the counseling of students and safety environment organized in the campus of the institute. The feedback given by the students in regard to the curriculum offered by Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune was of course, satisfactory. The students expressed the dire need of field visits, experiential learning, and academic flexibility to learn interdisciplinary course content. In addition to the students, even the alumni of the institute were happy and content with the curriculum offered by the University. The alumni observed that the course contents offered were relevant to their job profiles and also apt, and suitable for future aspirations. Naturally, the course content designed in the Savitribai Phule Pune University curriculum opened a vista of job opportunities in different fields to alumni and enabled them to learn research skills to groom their overall personality development. As per as the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS 2019) introduced by the University was concerned, it was found that the teachers were also content with it and opined that the courses offered are relevant and focus on skill enhancement, employment generation, technical skill enhancement and meet the needs of the students and also the recent updates in the subject domain.




Fig. 1 Students' feedback on the curriculum




Fig. 2 Teachers' feedback on the curriculum




Fig. 3 Alumni feedback on the curriculum
