
6. In case, the study involves survey research, the finalized schedules/questionnaires (2 copies) designed to elicit information should be sent to the ICSSR as per the following schedule:

- a) If the schedule /questionnaire for eliciting information is as per standard questionnaire, these will have to be sent to ICSSR immediately,
7. **The Second instalment** will be released after receiving a satisfactory six/nine/ twelve months Progress Report (depending on the duration of the programme), simple statement of account of first instalment, published peer reviewed journal, along with grant-in-aid bill towards the second instalment.
 8. **The Third instalment** will be released will be released after receiving second Progress Report (depending on the duration of the programme), simple statement of accounts of the second instalment, along with grant-in-aid bill towards the third instalment.
 9. **The Fourth Instalment** will be released after receiving book length Final Report in soft copy (both word and PDF format), Executive Summary of Final Report in soft copy (both word and PDF format), 500 words abstract of the Final Report in soft copy, research papers published in peer reviewed journals duly acknowledging ICSSR, similarity index score sheet, simple statement of accounts of third instalment along with grant-in-aid bill towards the fourth instalment.
