There is a lack of opportunity for fundamental research in India. The young researchers must work in the field of discovery of new drugs to treat TB and Malaria diseases which is the need for countries like India.

Technical Session II: The speaker for this session was Prof. Brijesh Pare, President of the Association of Chemistry Teachers and Head, Department of Chemistry, Govt Madhav Science PG College, Ujjain guided the participant on the topic “**The significance of Chemical Revolution Initiated by Lavoisier**”. He said that the students of Chemistry must know how the discoveries are made. He explained the history of the discovery of Oxygen in a very lucid language.

Technical Session III: The speaker for this session was Mr. Charitra Gour, Technical consultant at Scube Scientific Software Solutions Pvt Ltd, New Delhi who guided the participant on the topic- “**Features of ChemDraw**”. He explained the importance of ChemDraw software for research with a practical demonstration of the same. The queries raised by the participant were also answered by the resource person.

Prof Bimal Roy, Chairman, National Statistical Commission, Dr. Preeti Sudan, Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Prof. Sanghamitra Bandyopadhyay, Director, Indian Statistical Institute, International Participants from UN Women, UN ESCAP and other stakeholders will also participate in the event through video conferencing.

In 2019, the Ministry instituted a new award, namely, the Prof. P.C. Mahalanobis National Award in Official Statistics for recognizing outstanding achievement of official statisticians in Central Government, State Governments and Institutions. The Prof.P.C. Mahalanobis National Award winner, 2020 will be felicitated during the event.

The Ministry recognises the outstanding contribution for high quality research work in the field of applied and theoretical statistics benefitting the official statistical system through the

Prof. C. R. Rao and Prof. P. V. Sukhatme awards, awarded in alternate years. For 2020, the award winner for Prof. P. V. Sukhatme will be declared during the event. The winners of 'On the Spot Essay Writing Competition, 2020' for Post Graduate Students on the subject relevant to Statistics organized at All India level will also be felicitated.

Every year, Statistics Day is celebrated with a theme of current national importance, which runs for a year by way of several workshops and seminars, aimed at bringing about improvements in the selected area. The theme of Statistics Day, 2019 was "Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)" and carrying this forward the theme of Statistics Day, 2020 is selected as **SDG- 3 (Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages) & SDG- 5 (Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls).**

Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation(MOSPI) celebrates this day on national level.

Professor Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis was a renowned scientist and statistician who had contributed a lot to Indian statistics. He was a recipient of the 'Padma Vibhushan', which is a prestigious civilian award in India.

National Statistics Day History:

The government of India decided in 2006 to celebrate Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis's birthday, 29 June, every year as "National Statistics Day" of India.

National Statistics Day was first celebrated on June 29, 2007 to acknowledge the outstanding contributions of Prof. P C Mahalanobis in the fields of economic planning and statistical development.

His birth anniversary on June 29 was chosen as the National Statistics Day and a notification for this was first published in the Gazette of India on June 5, 2007.

On the occasion of his 125th birth anniversary on 29 June 2018, Indian Vice-President M Venkaiah Naidu released a commemorative coin at a programme at ISI, Kolkata.

National Statistics Day is organized by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and various seminars, programs, competitions, and discussions are also organized on this day.

On the same background we all SPPU Statistics teachers decided to celebrate National Statistics Day through quiz followed by a lecture of expert at their college level.

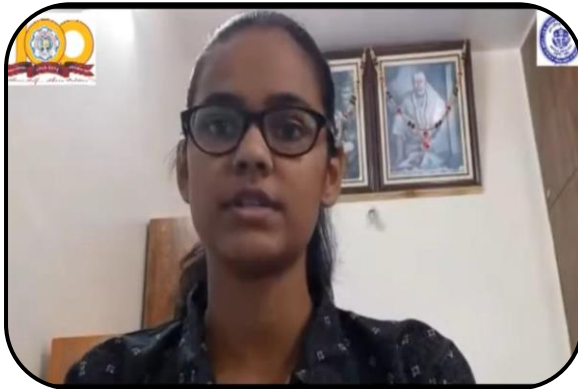
