This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2023 between Maharaja Agrasen University having their campus at, Atal Shiksha Kunj, Nanakpur, Pinjore Nalagarh National Highway, near Barotiwala, Tehsil Baddi (Distt. Solan) Himachal Pradesh - 174103, represented by its Vice Chancellor - Dr. R. K. Gupta, as the First Party (hereinafter referred to as "University" or "MAU" or the "Institution")

And

**Gokhale Education Society's**

**R.N.C. Arts, J.D.B. Commerce & N.S.C. Science College Nashik Road, Nashik -422101, Maharashtra, India** represented by its Principal Prof. Dr. Mrs. M. M. Kulkarni (herein after referred to as College" or the "Institution").

**Maharaja Agrasen University (MAU), Solan** is a Private University located in District Solan Himachal Pradesh and was established in the year 2013. The University is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) & Bar Council of India (BCI) and is recognized by The University Grants Commission of India (UGC). The University is envisioned to become an educational institution of the first choice of the students, teaching, and research community, and be recognized for providing excellent opportunities for global success. MAU offers various Diploma, Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctorate Level courses in a wide variety of fields like Basic & Applied Sciences, Law, Management, Pharmacy, and Technology.

Whereas, **R.N.C. Arts, J.D.B. Commerce & N.S.C. Science College** is established in the year 1963 and it is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The College offers courses in Arts, Commerce and Management and Science Faculty. It also runs a Commerce Research Centre which registers students for M. Phil and Ph.D. in 05 Subjects. The aforesaid organizations are hereafter referred to individually as *College* and collectively as *Institutions*.

**OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU**

In the spirit of friendship and with mutual interest in cooperation, the areas of cooperation will include any programme offered at either Institution as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two organizations and to promote joint educational, research and cultural collaborations.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:





1. Exchange of faculty and/or staff
2. Exchange of students
3. Joint teaching, research, or cultural activities
4. Joint organization of seminars and academic meetings
5. Faculty/Staff professional development
6. Exchange of academic materials and other related information
7. Special short-term academic programs

#### **DURATION AND EVALUATION OF MOU**

1. This MOU will come into operation with effect from the date of signing and will remain in force and effect for a period of three years or until the Termination Date. Either party may request termination of this agreement, in writing, ninety days prior to the proposed termination date.
2. A joint evaluation of the MOU will be initiated by the designated representatives of the two Institutions six months prior to the expiration date. Following the evaluation, the MOU may be renewed and extended for an additional five year period.
3. Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either party and approved by the authorized signatories of the two Institutions.

#### **AREA OF COLLABORATION**

1. Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either University and may include, but are not limited to the above activities. Any other related academic, cultural or research activity may be undertaken on mutual understanding between the two Institutions.
2. Any specific activity developed under this MOU shall be detailed in a subsequent agreement, signed by each Institution's authorized signatory, which will describe the scope of the proposed activity, intended outcomes, budget, and responsible departments or individuals.
3. All activities shall be subject to the availability of funds and with the approval of each Institution's authorized representatives.



### **NON-DISCRIMINATION**

The parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of religion, race, creed, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, handicap, political affiliation, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.

### **COMPLIANCE WITH LAW**

The parties specifically intend to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations as they may be amended from time to time. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate central, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith, revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required to bring the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty days prior written notice to the other party.

### **FORCE MAJEURE**

In the event, students are unable to complete the Program due to but not limited to: acts of God; war; acts of the government; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes, labor disputes or work stoppages; transportation contingency; and freight embargoes; other catastrophes or any similar occurrences beyond the reasonable control of both of the Institutions, the initiator Institution will assist the affected students in finding an alternate site/mode to complete the Program.

### **STUDENT EXCHANGE**

- ✓ The aim of the exchange program is to provide students an opportunity to have experience of diverse academic environment as well as to gain a better understanding of related concepts borne under this MOU through education.
- ✓ The number of students exchanged under this MOU shall be not more than twenty students at a time from each Institution end. The total number of mutually exchanged students will be same from each Institution during the term of MOU.
- ✓ The host Institution has the right to decide acceptance of exchanged students, by taking account of recommendation issued from the home Institution for exchanged students based on their academic record.
- ✓ The host Institution will waive application fees, entrance fees, and tuition fees of the exchanged students. Transportation, accommodation, food, clothing and other personal costs including the medical health insurance and medical care will be the personal responsibilities



of the students themselves. However, the host Institution may charge an amount for providing laboratory, library, internet facilities etc. The amount will be intimated at the time of making an offer.

- ✓ The host Institution shall reserve or make available accommodation on campus for exchanged students or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.
- ✓ The exchanged student is treated as either research student or specially registered student.
- ✓ The exchanged students will be subject to the student rules of the host University, while on exchange. Exchanged students will be offered the same facilities as students of the host Institution.
- ✓ Exchanged students will study subjects or conduct researches which are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host Institution.
- ✓ The acceptance of course work (lectures, seminars) taken at the host Institution and the measure of achievement attained there will be communicated to the home Institution.

#### FACULTY EXCHANGE

- ✓ The two Institutions will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutual agreed periods.
- ✓ Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-term and long-term visits of faculties, joint research and development projects.
- ✓ Both Institutions will try to seek external funding to facilitate these exchanges.
- ✓ Both Institutions will encourage their faculty for co-authored publications, joint research activities and joint projects subject to applicable copyright and / or other laws of the country, as well as rules and regulations of the respective Institutions.
- ✓ The host Institution will endeavor to, as much as possible, make available such facilities as will enable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes, including the use of its laboratories and libraries.
- ✓ The two Institutions acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel, living and allied costs will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home Institution.





### **RESEARCH AND PROJECT COLLABORATION**

- ✓ Joint Research Work will be carried out by Faculty Members from both the institutions.
- ✓ Joint Research Projects will be carried at Faculty as well as Institution level.
- ✓ Students from the both the Institutions can work on common Research Projects.
- ✓ Joint Research Paper in UGC Care List/ Peer Reviewed Journals will be published at Faculty and Students' Level
- ✓ Joint Books/ Projects will be published at Faculty and Students' Level.

### **COORDINATORS**

Both Institutions will designate persons responsible for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

### **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two Institutions.

### **EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION**


Information will be actively exchanged, including information about students, information on research and studies provided at the host/home organization, relevant information about faculty members and fields of research, and Institution publications.

Other faculty members such as Dr.Datir and Prof. Bhagwat are also with us they help us in collection of different plants like Riccia, Sphagnum, forms of Lichens etc.

### **ABOUT ANKAI FORT अंकाई / अणकाई**

**Ankai** is a historic site found in the Satmala Range hills in western India. It is located in Yeola Taluka of Nashik district in the state of Maharashtra. Geographically, it is near Maumad. The Ankai fort and Tankai fort are two different forts on adjacent hills. A common fortification is constructed to secure both. The Ankai fort is located on a hill with perpendicular scarps on all the sides, except for a narrow nose on the eastern side.

#### History

The Brahmani (Hindu) caves on the fort and the Jain caves at the base of the fort depict that Ankai was constructed around 1000 years ago. The fort was built by Yadava of Devgiri. Mughals led by Shah Jahan's

General Khan Khanan captured this fort in 1635 by bribing the fort commander. In 1665, Thévenot mentions these forts as a stage between the cities of Surat and Aurangabad. Ankai was ultimately captured by the Nizam from the Mughuls. In 1752, the fort came under control of the Maratha empire after the Treaty of Bhalgi. Finally, it was captured by the British in 1818.

#### **How to reach**

The nearest town is Manmad which is 97 kilometers from Nashik. The base village of the fort is Ankai which is 10 kilometers from Manmad. There are three routes to reach Ankai from Nashik. The shortest and safest is via Manmad, the other two are via Vinchur-Lasalgaon-Patoda (85 km) and via Yeola (108 km). The Ankai railway station is quite close to the village. Local passenger trains passing on the Manmad-Nizamabad route stop at the railway station. The trekking path starts from the hillock north of the Ankai village. The route is free from obstruction and is safe and wide with regular steps to the fort. It takes about half an hour to reach the entrance gate of the fort. It takes about 3 hours to see both the forts. It is advisable to first visit the Ankai fort in the early hours of the morning and complete the Tankai fort before noon.

#### **Places to see**

There are a lot of places to be seen around the fort, including:

**The Jain caves** located at the foot hills of the fort, spanning two stories. On the lower story there are two caves, neither of which have idols. On the upper story, there are five caves which feature Mahavir idols in good condition. They are secured by lock and key at night to avoid vandalism. There are carvings of Yaksha, Indrani, lotus and Lord Mahavir in the main cave.

**The Main Gate** is located south of the hill, featuring well preserved woodwork.

**The Manmad Gate** is on the Northern side of the col facing Manmad city.

**The Brahmani (Hindu) Caves** are near the entrance gate to the upper plateau of Ankai fort. They are in ruins, but the idols of Jai and Vijay carved out of rock and the Shivinga can still be seen.

**The Palace and Kashi Pond** On the western edge of the plateau is a large palace in a dilapidated condition. Only the walls of the palace remain. Among the rock cut cisterns on the way to the palace is the Kashi pond, with a holy Tulsi pot engraved in rock placed in the center of the pond.



. We took photographs of many flowering plants for herbaria. Then we enjoy lunch and start return journey and reached in the Jain ashram where we gathered together ,enjoy tea and given vote of thanks to Dr.Shimpi

for accepting the invitation and participation in a excursion tour and guided us too much about the biodiversity of Anka as a resource person. At 4.00pm we come back to college.




