The NSS Unit of our college is organizing an International Yoga Day program on **June 21st, 2022 at 9:00 am in seminar hall.**



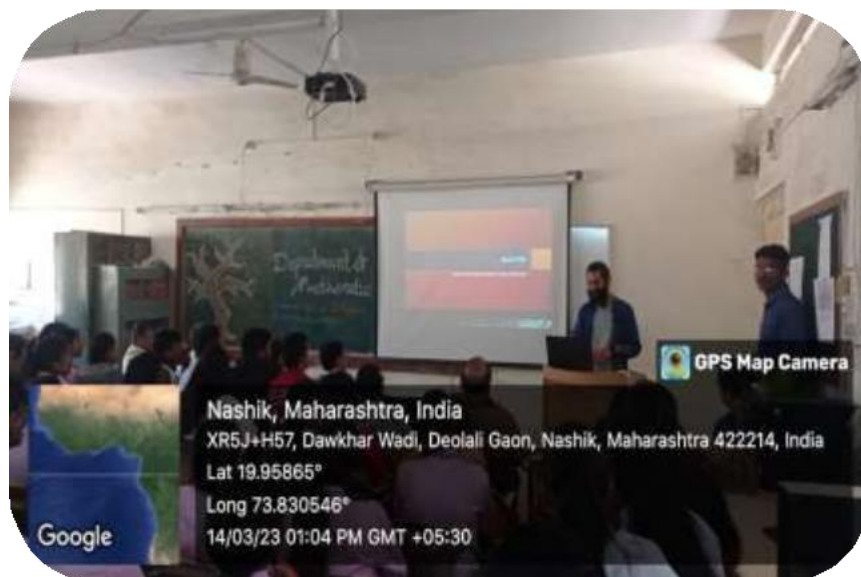


Students attending the lecture
